Legal background

- > Act XC of 2017 on Criminal Proceedings
 - → entered into force on 1st July 2018
- > paradigm shift

obligation to be present at the trial → right to be present at the trial



The types of in absentia proceedings

A) the defendant waives his right to attend the hearing

- the defendant has a legal counsellor, and
- entrusts the legal counsellor with the function of agent for service of project

B) the defendant is at an unknown location

- the defendant fled or hid during the process
- the means taken in order to locate the residence of the absent defendant have had no success within a reasonable time
- the severity of the crime justifies it

C) the defendant's place of residence is known but it is in abroad



Defence by a legal counsellor

- > always obligatory
- > the legal counsellor can be mandated or appointed
- > legal counsellor may act independently
- > has the right to appeal or to ask for a remedy independently



Remedies

> appeal or ask for retrial

appeal	retrial
full or limited limited appeal is against only - the punishment, - the disposition on the auxiliary issues, or - the justification of the verdict	full
15 days	30 days
